2022 Ottavino St. Laurent Ricci Vineyard, Los Carneros (Sonoma)

With roots in Austria, this wine comes from the only commercial vineyard growing St. Laurent in the US. St. Laurent is thought to be related to pinot noir and shares some of the softness of that variety. Situated in close proximity to the San Pablo Bay in Los Carneros (Sonoma), Ricci vineyard enjoys patterns of thick morning fog and cool afternoon winds which help develop flavor and retain acidity.

Deep, purple-hued, the St. Laurent is gorgeous in the glass. A pleasantly low 11.1% abv, the wine is still packed with dense blackberries and cherry coulis while framed by light tannins and a plush palate. Paired with anything and everything from a hearty lasagna to your holiday turkey, St. Laurent is a versatile wine. Or just sip on it by itself while you get the party started! *Drink now and over the next 5-7 years.*
